Date/time: January 20, 8 a.m. – 12 noon
Location: Pollard Auditorium
Description: Neonatal Resuscitation Program Provider Course is for those who have or have not previously completed Neonatal Resuscitation Program. Prior to attending this hands-on skills course, the learner must have completed and passed the 6th Edition NRP Online Examination. On the day of the course, learners will be expected to demonstrate the skills associated with the online lessons as well as participate in simulation and debriefing exercises.

Title: NRP
Date/time: February 9, 1 – 5 p.m.
Location: Pollard Auditorium
Description: Neonatal Resuscitation Program Provider Course is for those who have or have not previously completed Neonatal Resuscitation Program. Prior to attending this hands-on skills course, the learner must have completed and passed the 6th Edition NRP Online Examination. On the day of the course, learners will be expected to demonstrate the skills associated with the online lessons as well as participate in simulation and debriefing exercises.

FEBRUARY 2012 (CONTINUED)

Title: S.T.A.B.L.E.*
Date/time: February 10, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.
Location: Pollard Auditorium
Description: The S.T.A.B.L.E. Transport Education Program is an educational tool for community hospital caregivers and was developed to serve as a guideline for the pre-transport stabilization and care of sick newborns. The program is designed to provide important information about neonatal stabilization for maternal/infant healthcare providers in all settings – from community hospitals and birth centers, to emergency rooms and more complex hospital environments. The course is intended for the period following successful resuscitation of the newborn, until care is transferred to the transport team.

Title: Neonatal Low Risk/Neonatal High Risk
Date/time: February 21, Neonatal Low Risk: 8 a.m. – noon, Neonatal High Risk: 1 p.m. – 5 p.m.
Location: Pollard Auditorium
Description: This course will discuss Low Risk Neonatal Care in the morning session and High Risk Neonatal Care in the afternoon sessions. Examples of content for Low Risk course include: Special Considerations of the Late Preterm Infant, Drug Withdrawal and an Interactive Case Study Lecture with common newborn topics such as Hypoglycemia, Hypothermia and Respiratory Distress. Examples of content for the high risk course include: Apnea of Prematurity, Surgical Emergencies and Persistent Pulmonary Hypertension of the Newborn. Learners may attend one or both sessions. Attendees will receive contact hours based on the number of hours they attend the course.

MARCH 2012

Title: NRP Instructor
Date/time: March 6, 8 a.m. – 5 p.m.
Location: Pollard Auditorium
Description: The primary responsibility of the hospital-based instructor is to implement and maintain an on-going Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) within the hospital or institution. The hospital-based instructor course provides the information and skills required to develop and implement an NRP provider course. It is essential that the hospital-based instructor possess the knowledge and skills presented in the provider course. There are multiple requirements that must be met to attend this course set forth from the AAP. Upon registration the learner will be informed of these requirements.

Title: Back to the Basics: Low Risk Obstetric Care
Date/time: March 16, 8 a.m. - noon
Location: Pollard Auditorium
Description: Topics to be covered include: The Ups and Downs of Postpartum Depression and Postpartum Pathophysiology. Additional topics on NBN and L&D will also be covered. More details to come on our online calendar.

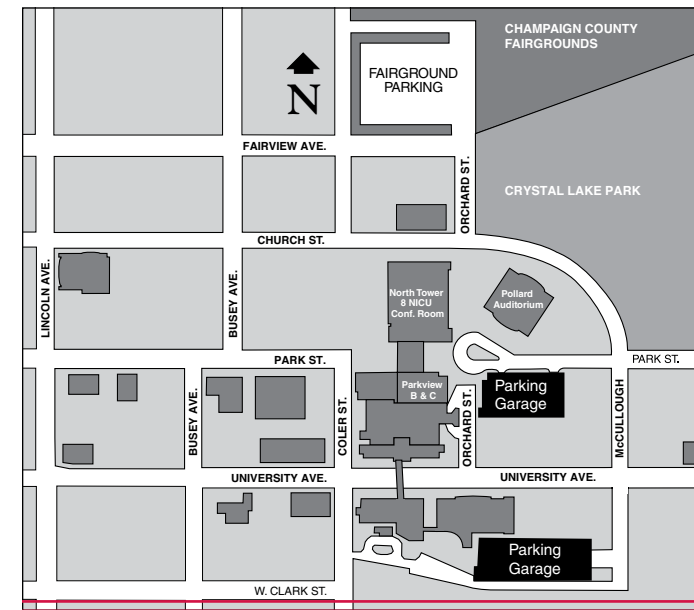
